

Order Purchase The board authorized the purchase of clothing, as indicated below, for J. L. McCann, now at Bonner Springs Sanatorium - 1 coat, 1 pair pants, 1 pair shoes, 1 pair overalls, 2 pairs undershorts, 3 pair socks.

Increment Upon motion of Commissioner Cox, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Hoover, and passed unanimously, the salary of the deputy sheriff from and after July 1, 1919, was fixed at \$100.00 the month.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all members present, and Commissioners and Chairman W. Andrews presiding.

Increment Upon motion of Commissioner Cox, which motion at first was not seconded, the salary of the deputy clerk of Court was set at \$35.00 the month. The Chairman Andrews moved as an amendment that the sum be \$40 a month, and this amendment was accepted by Mr. Cox. Commissioner Hoover seconded Commissioner Cox's motion fixing the salary at \$35 a month. A vote being taken on the amendment as offered by Commissioner Andrews, it resulted in Commissioner Andrews + Cox voting affirmatively and Commissioner Hoover voting in the negative. Chairman Andrews declared the amendment to the motion carried.
