

Thursday, July 10 - 1919.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all commissioners present, W. Commission & Chairman A. Andrews presiding.

Minutes The minutes of the meeting of the board for the months of March, April, May & June, 1919, were read. Upon motion of Commissioner Cox, seconded by Commissioner Hoover, the minutes of the board for the months indicated above, as read by the clerk, were approved.

Appoint The board took up the matter of the appointment of a Commissioner of the Poor. The clerk read the names of three applicants, as follows: A. J. Hamlin, Wm Mesenhimer, B. B. Hummelt. The chairman ordered a vote, which resulted as follows: W. B. Hummelt 2, Wm Mesenhimer 1. The clerk, having announced the result of the vote, the chairman declared that B. B. Hummelt, having received a majority of the votes cast, was elected Commissioner of the Poor for two years. The board determined that he assume office August 1, 1919.

Endora The chairman of the board, Mr. A. Andrews, was authorized to sign a petition directed to the State Highway Commission asking that the Board of County Commissioners of Lawrence County be directed to cooperate with the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County in the bearing of the repairs at the north end of the Endora bridge crossing the Kansas River, & to pay their pro rata of expense.

Designate The petition of certain electors of School District No. 17, asking for the order of the board for a special election in said district to vote bonds for the construction of a school building was approved, and August 26, 1919, was by the board designated as the date for holding said special election.

Old Bills The bills of Chas. Crowder, deputy sheriff, for the months of April, May & June, 1919, were ordered paid at the rate of \$75.00 per month. The bills of Mrs. L. L. Moss for services as deputy clerk of Court, for the months of April, May & June, 1919, were ordered paid at the rate of \$20.00 per month.

Check for The clerk announced the receipt of a check for \$3172.00 from the Auditor of State, as payment to the County for the keep & care of indigent insane. The clerk announced that the check had been turned over to C. M. Murren, and his receipt taken therefor.

Approve Co. The bond of John M. Murlin, appointed Co. Treasurer, in amount of \$15,000, given by the National Surety Co. was approved.
