- On Official Business The board this date drove through Wakarusa, Palmyra, Bridge & Willow Springs, Marion & Clinton townships on an official survey road, bridge and culvert inspection trip. The County engineer accompanied them.

- At Baldwin the Board, after viewing what is known as the Baldwin Hill & conferring with business men of that city, authorized the opening of the hill. The opening of this hill contemplates the removal of all loose stones, the grading & ditching and the application of between 5,000 and 6,000 gallons of oil, at a total cost approximately of \$500. Mr. Geo. J. Morley of Kansas City, Mo., was awarded the work. The board returned late in the evening.

- Condensed The chairman of the Board met with a deputy from the St. Louis Live Stock Commission and approved a tubercle cow belonging to R. W. Emice at \$125.00.
