The board met in adjourned regular session, all the commissioners present, and Commissioner and Chairman A. Andrews presiding.

The board authorized publication of the following two "Notices to Road Contractors," in relation to Fort to Fort Highway, Project No. 7, to-wit:

Notice to Road Contractors-

1. Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals for the construction of Federal Aid Road work in Douglas County, State of Kansas, said road work known as the Fort to Fort road, Section E, Project No. 7, will be received at the office of the county clerk at Lawrence, Kansas, until 11:00 o'clock A.M. August 16-1919, and thus publicly opened.
2. The proposed work is located on the public highway in the county before mentioned. Said proposed improvement includes the construction of excavation, embankment, culverts, bridges and walls, together with all the work involved and indicated by the plans and specifications herewith, beginning at Station 70 + 00, a point at the west end of Section D, and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 19235 feet, of which 19235 feet are to be improved. The point of beginning is approximately 2 1/2 miles by road from the A. T. & S. F. Ry. passenger depot at Lawrence, Kansas.
3. Detailed information of the work to be done may be had by an examination of the plans and specifications on file in the office of the county clerk and County Engineer.
4. The Board of Commissioners reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to waive technicalities.
