

Saturday, August 2, 1919.

The board met in regular session, all Commissioners present, Chairman A. Andrews presiding.

The board of D. B. Hummelt, Chas. Commission of the Poor, with H. W. Eggert & C. Postman as surties, was presented & approved.

The board, after consideration increased, by \$10.00, the amount to be allowed by the county as damages for horse taken from C. J. News for an additional right of way for Fort to Fort Increased Highway Project #7.

At 2:00 o'clock the board considered in public session for the purpose of hearing complaints from county residents on the estimates of cost, etc., covering the bridge & culvert project for 1919-20. No complaints were received.

The question of payment for rock, or macadamizing, a portion of the Lime Kiln Hill, was taken up. The Wabasca Township board meeting with the County board, in an effort to Beat Part reach some understanding as to what proportion each board's expense was to pay. The Wabasca board agreed to the payment of \$500.00 of the original amount, the county assuming the remainder.

The matter was taken under advisement.

The hearing on the Hung Red road petition was set for Saturday, Aug. 23, 1919.
