

Resolution Kansas, in regular session convened on this 9<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1919, finds on due and proper proof that the sum of \$1,200 per year is insufficient to properly and efficiently conduct the business of the office of County Treasurer of said county. Now, therefore, it is hereby ordered that the sum of \$1,500 per year be, and the same is hereby allowed, for deputy clerk hire for said office until the further orders of this board, said order to be effective on and after the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, 1919, this finding and order being made under the provisions of Chapter 196 of the Session Laws of 1919, state of Kansas.

Resolution The above resolution, being urged for adoption by Commissioner Cox and seconded by Commissioner Horner, was voted upon, all Commissioners voting for its adoption and not one against, Chairman Andrews declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Cox offered the following resolution and moved its adoption =

Resolution Whereas the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session convened on this 9<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1919, finds on due and proper proof that the sum of \$1,200 per year is insufficient to properly and efficiently conduct the business of the office of County Clerk of said county.
