

Resolution Kansas, in regular session convened on this 9<sup>th</sup> day of  
Increasing, August, 1919, finds on due & proper proof that the sum of  
Salary Dept. \$1,200 per year is insufficient to properly & efficiently conduct  
the business of the office of County Treasurer of said County.

Now, therefore, it is hereby ordered that the sum of \$1,500 per  
year be, be the same as herby allowed, for deputy Clerk here for  
said office until the further orders of this board, said order to  
be effective on and after the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, 1919, this  
finding and order being made under the provisions of Chapter 196  
of the Session Laws of 1919, state of Kansas.

Resolution The above resolution, being urged for adoption by Commissioner  
Passed by Cox and seconded by Commissioner Horner, was voted upon, all  
voted as Commissioners voting for its adoption and not one against, Chair-  
man Andrews declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Cox offered the following resolution and  
moved its adoption =
