

Resolution Kansas in
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MINUTES OF MEETING OF JOINT BOARD COMPOSED OF THE BOARD OF
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, AND THE
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, KANSAS,
UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 92 OF THE SESSION LAWS OF
KANSAS OF 1921.

And now on this 10th day of August, A.D. 1921, at a meeting
of the Joint Board, composed of the Board of County Commissioners of
Douglas County, Kansas, and the Board of Commissioners of the City
of Lawrence, Kansas, under the provisions of Chapter 92 of the Ses-
sion Laws of Kansas of 1921, comes on for consideration and action
the surveys, plans, specifications and estimate of the cost of the
improvement of North Seventh Street as provided in the Final Reso-
lution adopted July 13th, 1921 by the Board of Commissioners of the
County of Douglas, Kansas, and by the Board of Commissioners of the
City of Lawrence, Kansas, and as ordered by said Joint Board above
referred to on July 13th, 1921, and said Joint Board, after exami-
nation of said Surveys, Plans, Specifications and Estimate of Cost,
as submitted by William S. Henderson, City Engineer of Lawrence, Kan-
sas, and after due consideration thereof, finds:

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First: That said Surveys, Plans and Specifications provide
for the most expedient and advisable route and the best method of
construction for the proposed improvement of North Seventh Street
from Locust Street north to the north limits of the City of Law-
rence, Kansas, as ordered by the Final Resolution of July 13th, 1921,
above referred to.

Second: That said Surveys, Plans, Specifications and Estimate
of Cost have been approved by the County Engineer of Douglas County,
Kansas.

Third: That said Surveys, Plans, Specifications and Estimate
of Cost should be approved by this Joint Board, and a date fixed for
receiving bids for the proposed improvement.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE JOINT BOARD, composed of
the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Kansas,
and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, a
majority of each of said Board concurring therein, that the Surveys,
Plans, Specifications and Estimate of the Cost of the proposed im-
