Commissioner Cook introduced the following preamble to the resolution adopted by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, as follows:

"That the following resolution heretofore on the 11th day of August, 1919, legally adopted by the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, be and the same is hereby by the Board of County Commissioners duly adopted and ordered published as provided by law, said resolution being in words & figures as follows, to-wit:

"Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, which is a city of the second class, located in Douglas County, Kansas, which is a county having a population exceeding 20,000, deems it expedient and advisable and a public necessity to grade, curb, gutter, or otherwise improve North Seventh street in said city of Lawrence, formerly known as Maine street, in that part of the city known as North Lawrence, from Locust street to the north city limits, in order to connect said Locust street, the same being a paved street, with the hard surfaced road now under process of construction running north from the north city limits along the north and south line between Sections 19 & 20, in Township 17, Range 20, in Douglas County, Kansas, in accordance with the provision of Chapter 109 of the Session Laws of 1919 of the State of Kansas.

"Therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, that said North Seventh street in the City of Lawrence, Kansas, be graded, curbed, guttered, paved or otherwise improved from a point commencing about 175 feet west from the intersection of Locust street & North Seventh street, thence curving on a radius of about 300 feet to join with said North Seventh street at a point about 175 feet north of the north line of said Locust street & continuing thence north along the general line of said North Seventh street to the north city limits of said city. That said street be paved or otherwise improved at a width of eighteen feet, with such width at corners as good engineering practice may require, and that said paving be constructed of concrete according to plans and specifications to be prepared by the City Engineer. That in order to provide for the payment of the cost of said improvement, in accordance with statute in such case made & provided, as may be assessed against the benefit district to be created within said city of Lawrence, the sum
