Endora

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Commissioner Roe of Lawrence County moved
the Commission Cor of Douglas County recorded the
motion, that advertisements be prepared as published
in the official County papers the legal number of times
asking for bids for the construction of dykes along the
both bank of the Kansas river, west of the bridge, opposite
Endora, for the protection of the north end of the Endora
bridge. The bid was called for to be opened 12 o'clock noon Sept. 26, in the
bridge room of the Lawrence County Court, in Lawrenceville.

A vote on the adoption of the above resolution being
ordered all the Commissioners comprising the joint
board voted aye, and not one vote being cast against
the motion Chairman that declared the motion cor-
ried.

The bill of the Missouri Valley Bridge & Iron Co.,
for \$3,282.64, for work in repairing the north end
of the Endora bridge, was taken up, and it was agreed
by the joint board that each county would bear
its proportionate share of this expense, the expense to be
divided on the basis of assessed valuation.

Upon motion the joint board adjourned
The Douglas County board returned to Lawrence late in
the evening.

Friday, September 5-1919-

The board met in regular adjourned regular session,
all commissioners present, the Commissioner and Chairman
A. Andrews presiding.

Claims against the county were presented, audited and allowed,
for which see September Allowance Record.

Upon request of the County Attorney, the hearing on the Henry Road
road petition was further postponed until Friday, Sept. 12, 1919.
