

At 3:00 o'clock the Commissioners assembled. Upon motion of Commissioner Cox, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Hoover, the bid of the Central Construction Co. of Kansas City, Mo., on Section E of #21,396.11, was accepted. A vote on the adoption of the resolution being ordered, all the Commissioners voted aye, and not one vote being cast negative, Chairman Andrews declared the motion adopted, and that the Central Construction Co. of K. C. Mo., had been awarded the work on Section E, Federal Aid Project No. 7, Federal Road District No. 5, at \$21,396.11.

Commissioner Hoover moved, and Commissioner Cox seconded the motion, that the bid of the List & Gifford Construction Co., of K. C., Mo., on Section F of #46,470.79, be accepted. A vote being ordered & taken on the adoption of the resolution, all the Commissioners voted aye, and not one vote being cast in the negative, Chairman Andrews declared the motion adopted, and that the List & Gifford Construction Co., of K. C., had been awarded the work on Section F, Fort to Fort Highway, Federal Aid Project No. 7, Federal Road District No. 5, at \$46,470.79.

Upon motion of Commissioner Cox, seconded by Commissioner Hoover, the bids of List & Gifford Const. Co. of the Cook & O'Brien Const. Co., & the Stubbs & Long Const. Co., all on Section E, were rejected; also the bids of the Central Construction Co., the Cook & O'Brien Const. Co., & the Stubbs & Long Const. Co., all on Section F, Fort to Fort Highway, Federal Aid Project No. 7, Federal Road District No. 5, were rejected.
