

Friday, October 10 - 1919

The Board met in adjourned regular session, all Commissioners present, and Commissioner A. C. Andrews presiding.

Upon representation made by the Tax Department of the A. T. & S. F. Ry. Co. it appeared to the Board probable that an excess levy of 1-10 of a mill has been made, and for the city of Eschore 1.0 mill, the former appearing under the head of emergency bridge and the last mentioned an excess in the legal limit for general purposes. Owing to the time limit when it becomes necessary to turn over the books to the county treasurer for the collection of tax, and realizing it to be a physical impossibility to refigure and rewrite the tax rolls the Board authorized the clerk to notify the Santa Fe Ry. Co. that an application for refund or cancellation of the amount appearing as excess tax would be granted.
