The board met in regular session for the first day of the December meeting. All commissioners were present, + Commissioner + Chairman A. Anderson presided.

By motion made, seconded + adopted the clerk was instructed to notify the County Treasurer to apply the money received from the government on improvement of port roads in this County to liquidating accounts brought against the County in the improvement + construction of the Highway known as the East & East Road, Project No. 7. The same order was made to apply on future money received from the government covering the improvement of roads in Project No. 7.
