

Tuesday, December 2, 1919.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all Commissioners in attendance, and Commissioner & Chairman A. Condura presiding.

M. French Road Petition The board received the petition of John M. French and fifteen other residents of Douglas County, Kans., asking for the reviewing, surveying & laying out a road, described as follows, to wit:

"Beginning at a point where the southeast corner of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and the northwest corner of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 36, T. 11, R. 17 in Douglas County, Kansas, lie and are adjacent to the public highway road often we running north and south on the half section line through said section 36; thence running east on the half section line running east and west between said N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 36, eighty rods. Said road to be forty feet wide, equally divided on each side of said half section line running east and west through said Sec. 36 as above described."

The board designated Friday, April 16, 1920, as the day and date upon which said proposed road would be viewed and appointed A. L. Cox, Allison Condura, and John L. Hoover as viewers, who, with the County Surveyor, are to meet at the point of beginning at 11:00 o'clock A.M., on the day & date above designated.

The minutes of the board meeting for the month of November, 1919, were read, and after ordering a record made of the attendance of the board at a meeting held before the Public Utilities Commission, in Lawrence, Monday, November 17, 1919, upon motion made, seconded and passed, approved as shown.
