Commissioners. Cox moved that the total insurance to be written aggregate \$143,200 on the three county buildings, for term of one, then for five years, divided equally as near as possible for the three periods, with a 50% clause attached, but that the apportionment among the different agents be on the following basis:

Commissioner Horner seconded the motion, as a vote being taken on its adoption Commissioner Cox, Horner & Chairman Andrews voted in the affirmative, but not one vote being cast in the negative, Chairman Andrews declared the motion adopted.

Upon motion made, seconded and passed, insurance for the amount carried for fire insurance, likewise for the one, three and five year periods, is to apply as tornado risk on the three county buildings, the tornado risk to be apportioned among the various agents in amounts as requested for fire insurance.
