Credits Upon motion made by Commissioner Hoover, Second Allowed by Commissioner Cox, he passed, the board directed the Treasurer to take credit for \$202.49, as indicated in the above statement of losses incurred by reason of advance collection of tax on basis of 1918 rate.

The following petition for Rural High School was received by the Board, to-wit: To the Honorable, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas.

We, the undersigned, legal electors residing in a territory containing not less than sixteen square miles and comprising parts of Kanawake, Wakarusa & Leecompton townships in Douglas County, Kansas, being desirous of establishing a Rural High School district in conformity with the provisions of Chapter 311 of the Session Laws of Kansas of 1915, as amended by Chapter 284 of the Session Laws of 1917, do hereby petition your honorable body to call a special election for the purpose of voting on the proposition of establishing and locating a rural high school, and to vote bonds for the construction of a high school building.

The boundaries of said proposed rural high school district in which we, your petitioners, reside, are as follows: Beginning at the Kansas river at a point due north of the S.W. corner of Section 35, T. 11, R. 17, thence south to the S.W. corner of Section 35, T. 11, R. 17, thence east one mile, thence south one mile, thence east one mile, thence south one mile, thence east one mile, thence south one mile to the township line, thence east one-half mile, thence south one-half mile to the center of Section 29, T. 12, R. 18, thence east three miles to the center of Section 24, T. 12, R. 18, thence north one-half mile, thence east two miles, thence north one mile, thence east one mile, thence north one mile, thence east one mile, thence north to the Kansas river, thence up said river to the point of beginning.

The amount of bonds to be voted for the construction of said high school building shall be forty thousand dollars, said bonds to be of the denomination of from one to five hundred dollars each, bearing a rate
