The petition of the Alpha Xi Delta sorority for cancellation & refund of tax paid for 1919 was received by the Board & as the refund was concerned rejected it. The matter of cancellation of the remaining one-half tax for 1919 was upon motion made, seconded & passed, left to be determined by the State Tax Commission, accompanied by a recommendation of the board that the cancellation be granted.
