The board, acting upon orders from the State Tax Commission, decreed a cancellation of the remaining one-half of the taxes for 1919, amounting to \$61.12, & ordered that the property, now used by the Alpha Xi Delta Society, lot 254 Louisiana street, be exempt from further taxes so long as it is used by the society. This action was taken upon motion made, seconded & passed.

Dr. J. B. Henry, appointed County Health Officer & County Physician January 14 - 1920, declining to accept the position at the compensation provided by law, the board declared the post vacant, & upon motion made by Commissioner Cook, seconded by Commissioner Horvath & passed, appointed Dr. H. J. Jones as County Physician & County Health Officer, compensation to be \$75.00 per month & 10¢ per mile as mileage when traveling in the discharge of his duties. The above compensation includes my official inspection of said school house in the county each year.

The leaving on the effect of J. B. Henry from the decision of the County Superintendent of Public Instruction on his application for change from school district No. 31 to school district No. 25, which change was denied, was heard by the board. Upon motion made by Commissioner Horvath, seconded by Cook, & passed, the board sustained the decision of the County Superintendent of Public Instruction.

The board approved the two bonds of the Western National Bank, issued by the Bankers' Deposit Guaranty & Surety Co., each bond for \$15,000, & extending from January 25 - 1920, to January 22 - 1921, were approved by the board.
