

Monday, January 26 - 1920.

The board met in regular session, all commissioners present, the Commissioner - Chairman A. Andrews presiding.

The following resolution was introduced by Commissioner Cox, seconded by Commissioner Hoover, and passed, to-wit:

Resolved, That the County Engineer of Douglas County is hereby directed to prepare plans, specifications and estimates of the paving, curbing and sidewalk necessary for the completion of the north approach to the bridge across the Kansas river at Lawrence, Kansas, beginning at the north end of the bridge proper and extending north to the south curb line of Locust street in said city and to file the same with the County Clerk of said County, that thereupon said County Clerk is hereby ordered to advertise for bids for said project according to said plans, specifications and estimates above referred to, such advertisement to be continued for a period of sixty days in the official County paper, also in the Topeka Daily Capital and in the Engineering Record of New York City, N. Y. That each and every person, firm or corporation filing bids in such matter shall be required to file with the Board a good & sufficient certified check in an amount equal to 5 per cent of the amount of the bid, that the Board of County Commissioners meet at their office in said County on Saturday, April 3, 1920 at 12 o'clock noon open said bids. That said Board of County Commissioners reserve the right and power to reject any and all bids; and that the person, firm or corporation to whom such contract shall be let shall be required to file with the County Clerk of said County a good and sufficient bond of the amount of the contract price, containing the terms for such bonds provided in Chapter 71, Session Laws of 1913, Laws of Kansas -

Commissioner Cox introduced the following resolution, which was seconded by Commissioner Hoover, and passed, to-wit:

Resolved, That the County Attorney be, he is hereby authorized, to communicate with the K.C. R.V. & W. R.R. Co., informing it that the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, in the matter of the payment of rent on their contract for the last quarter of 1918, the payment is to be paid the County for laying part of the south approach to the Kansas river bridge at Lawrence, propose that upon the payment to the County of \$61.81, as per the letter of the County Attorney dated January 21-1920, and upon the agreement of said Company to stand all expense of shifting their tracks on the north approach to said bridge, which will be made necessary by the proposed paving of said bridge approach by the County, and upon permission of said company to cash this check to
