

Friday, February 6, 1920.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all Commissioners present, the Commissioner as Chairman, A. Andrew presiding.

The board consulted with the a Committee upon sending the Bankers of Lawrence as a representative of the Board. Commissioner Dr. Lee, of Wichita, with reference to issuing bonds for the purpose of taking up warrants issued in payment of contract work on the Fort to Fort Road. The offer made by the Brown-Crummer Co., netting 97 3/4 % on the dollar was rejected by the board, the bankers agreeing to continue to carry the county warrants until bids for the bonds can be advertised for & received.

Claims against the county were presented, audited and allowed, for which see February Allowance Record.

The board, in the afternoon, set as a canvassing board to convey the rate card at the Rural school election held in Leawards Saturday, Jan. 31, 1920. It was ascertained by a careful canvass of the returns made that of a total of 467 votes Election card, 245 votes were cast favoring the formation of a Rural High school within the territory as the Returns indicated in the petition filed with the C. Clerk December 16, 1919. & the issuing of bonds in amount \$40,000, 215 votes as opposing the proposition both as to formation of district & the issuing of bonds, & 7 votes defective for various reasons. The board approved the returns as certified by the judges & clerk of the special election & directed the C. Clerk to forward to the Co. Sept. a certified copy of the minutes of this meeting, insofar as it relates to the formation of the Rural High School district & the issuance of bonds.

Saturday, February 7, 1920.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all Commissioners present, the Commissioner as Chairman, A. Andrew presiding.

Upon Motion Made, seconded & passed, the board reconsidered the schedule of wages to be paid insofar as foreman on road & bridge work was concerned, changing the schedule of 40¢ per hour adopted at the meeting held January 26, 1920, to 50¢ per hour.
