The board met in regular session, all members in attendance, the Commissioner as Chairman A. Anderson presiding.

Through Resident Engineer Leonard, the List & Gifford Construction Co., constructing Section C, Project No. 7. Fort to Fort road, and J. D. Patterson & Co., constructing Section G, Project No. 7. Fort to Fort road, presented to the board written requests for extension of time in which to complete the work on these sections. The board after a thorough discussion of the matter, upheld the request of both applicant contractors.

The board approved the monthly reports of the Pro Commissioner and the Supt. of the County Home.

Report.

Sunday, February 16, 1920.

The board this morning drove to Arkalona Jefferson county, & met with the Jefferson county board in an effort to adjust the differences between the two county boards relating to a settlement of costs touching repairs on the Low river Co. Board bridge at Leesport. A satisfactory adjustment was effected, Jefferson county agreeing to pay their share of the expense involved. The board returned in mid-afternoon, and continued in session. All Commissioners present, the Commissioner as Chairman and Anderson presiding.

By direction of the State Tax Commission, the board ordered a cancellation of tax appearing on the 1919 tax roll against J. T. Johnson, in amount \$2.68, it being shown to the satisfaction of the board that he had not been granted the constitutional exemption of \$200+.

Upon motion made by Commissioner Cox, seconded by Commissioner Stover, and passed, the board designated Purchasing the County clerk as the purchasing agent for office supplies and Agents, by the various county officers.
