

Friday, March 5, 1920.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all the commissioners present. The Commissioner, Chairman A. Andrews presiding.

The minutes of the February meeting of the board were read by the clerk. Upon motion made, seconded and passed, were approved as read.

The board sat as a canvassing board to canvass the result of the election held Tuesday, March 2, for Board for the election of directors of the Maple Grove Drainage & of Maple Grove, Wakarusa, Hurkell & Endora Drainage districts. In the case of the Maple Grove Drainage district it was ascertained by a canvass of the votes that E. H. McNamee, District, Simon M. King & J. F. Pine had received a majority of the votes cast & accordingly were declared elected directors of the Maple Grove Drainage district. A total of 8 votes were cast.

A canvass of the votes cast in the Wakarusa, Hurkell & Endora Drainage district disclosed that 19 votes were cast, of which John Drinn received 13, Channing Shifford 14, James R. Thirer 13, John Carson 1, U. L. Holcom 1; 5 ballots were void by reason of irregular & unlawful marking. The board ~~declared~~ ^{found} that John Drinn, Channing Shifford & James R. Thirer, having received a majority of all the votes cast, were elected directors of the Wakarusa-Hurkell & Endora Drainage district & made that finding an official declaration.
