The board drove to Leavenworth this date, & with the Leavenworth county board of Commissioners met in joint session to consider the repair of the Eastern bridge approach & the construction of pile dykes on the north shore of the Kansas river for the protection of the bridge.

The joint board organized by the election of H. C. Short as Chairman; Miss Nichols, deputy clerk of Leavenworth County, acted as clerk. Upon motion of Commissioner Eberth of Leavenworth County, seconded by Commissioner Andrews of Douglas County, the County Clerk of the two counties were instructed to advertise for bids for the repair of the north approach to the Eastern bridge & for pile dykes for the protection of this approach and the bridge ~~on Thursday~~, to be opened Thursday April 15, 1920, at 12 o'clock m. upon the approval of the plans, specifications & estimates by the Court of Industrial Relations, bids to be opened at Lawrence.

The joint board adjourned.

(Addendum: Failure of the plans for the pile dykes to reach the Court of Industrial Relations in time for approval & return here in time to advertise for bids to be opened April 15, 1920, has necessitated a postponement of the initial advertisement & date for opening bids, which latter action was postponed to April 23, 1920, at 12 o'clock noon.

Thursday, March 20, 1920.

The board met in regular session, all commissioners present. Mr. Commissioner & Chairman A. Andrews presiding.
