The board designated Saturday, April 10, 1920, as a day for final hearing.

The board this date drove to Palmera township to ^{beginning} view the road petitioned for by W.E. Hoskinson and 18 others, described as follows: "Beginning at the corner of Sections 7, 12, 13, 18, Twp. 14, R. 21 and 21, extending south 1 mile to the corner of Secs. 15, 13, 24 & 14, Twp. 14, R. 20 and 21, in Douglas County, Kans.; we locate & establish a road as follows: Beginning on section line 20 ft. east of quarter section corner stone between Section 17 and 13, Twp. 14, R. 20, thence south one mile to a point 20 ft. east of quarter section ^{corner} stone between Secs. 13 and 24, Twp. 14, R. 20, in said County & state." The board designated Saturday, April 10, 1920, as a day for final hearing.
