

Saturday, March 27 - 1920.

The board met in regular session, all Commissioners present, but Commissioner & Chairman A. Andrews presiding.

Upon recommendation of the attending physician & the County Physicians, the Board authorized the admission of H. E. Reibman, a tubercular patient, to Ball Memorial Hospital, for a period of three weeks.

The board, having under consideration the application of Jesse Willard for an entrance into his premises from the Fort to Fort Highway, Commissioner Cox introduced the following resolution & moved its adoption, to-wit:-

Whereas, Jers. Willard has made application to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, requesting that said board to Construct at its expense a suitable entrance from the Fort to Fort Highway into the premises of J^{as} said Willard, at the north east corner of the said Willard premises; and

Whereas, the said Board of County Commissioners has been advised by M. W. Nelson, the engineer of the State Highway Commission, by letter under date of March 25, 1920, said letter being addressed to Allison Andrews, Chairman of the board, that the said Highway Commission would not approve of the construction of such an entrance at the point suggested, because the same would be dangerous to public travel; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, by the said Board of County Commissioners, in regular session convened on the 27th day of March, 1920, that the request of the said Jess Willard for the construction of an entrance to his premises at the point above mentioned be and the same is hereby denied; and be it further

Resolved, by the said Board, that tender be to the same is hereby made by the said Board to the said Willard of the construction by said Board at its own expense of a suitable entrance from the said Highway to the premises of the said Willard at a point directly south of Station 47 + 25, as indicated on the official plans and specifications of Section C of the Fort to Fort Highway in said County, but that said tender includes all the necessary excavations, fills and other necessary acts and items for the purpose of making at the point mentioned a good, practicable, safe and suitable entrance as aforesaid.
