

Be it further resolved by said board, that the clerk of said board be and he is hereby instructed, in addition to said advertisement, to communicate with all the bonding houses likely to be interested in said bonds, informing them of the terms and conditions as prescribed in said bonds, and that both advertisement and communications shall contain information giving the denomination of said bonds.

Commissioner Hoover seconded the resolution and a vote being ordered & taken, all the commissioners voted yes and not one vote being recorded in the negative, Chairman ~~Hoover~~^{Andrews} declared the motion for the adoption of the resolution carried.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all commissioners present, and Commissioner and Chairman A. Andrews presiding.

Upon order made by the State Tax Commission, the board directed a refund of the first one-half of the tax for 1869, in amount \$6,08, to the Alpha Xi Delta Society, paid under protest.

For like reason the board ordered a refund to F. M. Browning, in amount \$24.45, for the reason that the property on which the assessment was made had been assessed in Miami County, Kansas.

The board drove out to Grant Township, & viewed Section A & B & C to Wakarusa Township, to view the completed work on Section C.
