A, Fort to Fort road, from extension of time in which to finish work on their section, to December 1, 1920, was, by motion made, seconded and passed, refused, Commissioners Cox and Hoover voting against the extension, and Commissioner Andrews for the extension.

On motion of Commissioner Cox the County agreed to purchase a road map of Douglas County, in which all roads were numbered, from Mrs. Holland Wheeler. Consideration to be \$10.00.
