The board this day set as an equalizing board to hear complaints from Lawrence.

The assessment of J. Tyson, 1120 R.I. St. was reduced \$5.90.00 owing to excessive assessment on Government Bonds.

The board ordered the tax against Carl F. Hase, 901 Corn. St. assessed as the owner of a dog stricken off from the rolls, it being demonstrated to the satisfaction of the board that the animal belonged to Mrs. A. Wilson of Chanute, Kans.

With regard to the pavement on the north approach to the Kansas river bridge at Lawrence, Commissioner Cox introduced the following preamble and resolution and moved its adoption, to wit:

Whereas, the board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, entered into a contract with C. C. Clark on April 7, 1920, for the construction of brick pavement, together with curbing and guttering, on the north approach to the Kansas river bridge at Lawrence, Kansas, as per plans and specifications made a part of said contract; and

Whereas, it now appears that for reasons entirely beyond the control of the said C. C. Clark or anyone else connected with said contract, the said C. C. Clark is unable to procure brick for the surface of said pavement as provided in said plans and specifications; and

Whereas, the said C. C. Clark, in pursuance of said contract, has already constructed a considerable amount of concrete base for said pavement; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that said Board of County Commissioners, in regular session convened on the 25th day of May, 1920, that the County Engineer of Douglas County, Kansas, be and he is hereby instructed to draw amendment to said plans and specifications providing for good, substantial and satisfactory concrete surface to be substituted for brick surface in said pavement, and that upon the filing with the County Clerk of said county by the said C. C. Clark of full acceptance of the terms of said amendment, the said written acceptance to be made a part of said contract, and that upon the filing by the surety on the bonds of said C. C. Clark, to wit: The Lion Bonding & Surety Co., of its written consent to and acceptance of the terms of said amendment one copy of said written consent and acceptance to be filed with the County Clerk of said County and one copy to be filed with the District Clerk of said county, the said Board of County Commissioners will thereafter
