to believe that the above-named corporation has given to the assessor a false statement of its personal property, money, credits, investments in bonds, stock, joint companies, corporations or otherwise; and that the assessor has not returned the full amount of said property required to be listed in the city or township, and has omitted personal property, money, credits, investments in bonds, stocks, joint stock companies, corporations or otherwise, and has underestimated the same which by law are subject to taxation.

Now, therefore, you are hereby notified that you, the said Citizens' Light, Heat & Power Company, a corporation, may have opportunity of showing that the statement and return to the assessor hereinbefore referred to was correct and of showing reason, if any you have, why additional property of the kind and sort above set out shall not be placed upon the rolls of said county, and further opportunity of showing reason why, if any you have, the value of the property returned by you shall not be increased.

You are further notified that said opportunity will be given to you at a hearing before the said County Clerk and the said Board of County Commissioners which will be held on the 10th day of June, 1920, at 10:00 o'clock A.M. at the office of the County Clerk and said Board of County Commissioners in the Douglas County Court House at Lawrence, Kansas.
