

Report in Douglas County, at 70% of its value as above given. This, therefore, makes a valuation for taxation purposes of \$259,221, less the value of real property already appearing on the tax rolls of Douglas County and less also three other small personal property items as considered by the Assessor he appearing this year on the assessment rolls. The value of the real property just mentioned as already appearing on the tax rolls is \$1,740 and of the three other minor personal property items referred to above is \$3,110, and these two sums, totaling \$4,850, deducted from the \$259,221, nets \$247,371, which sum it is recommended by your board be placed on the assessment rolls of Douglas County for the year 1920 against the Citizens' Light, Heat & Power Co. & later extended on the tax rolls of the County for collection in manner as prescribed by law.

Just a few words more, not, however, by way of apology. It has been the aim and desire of the County Assessor to place a fair, equitable and legal assessment against the concern, and that, in the opinion of this officer, is the attitude of the Board of County Commissioners.

At the conclusion of the reading of the above, arguments were heard by the board, from Attorney Carl Klingman for the Citizens' Light, Heat & Power Co., & Attorney Thiele & Wilson for the County. At 12 o'clock adjournment was taken until 2 p.m., at which hour the board reconvened, and upon motion made by Commissioner Cox, seconded by Commissioner Hoover, & which motion, by a unanimous vote of the board was adopted, the board approved the report of the County Assessor & directed that the report be placed on the minutes of this board meeting, & the amount as indicated by the County Assessor be entered on the tax rolls of Douglas County for the year 1920.

The Citizens' Light, Heat & Power Co. by its attorney excepted to the findings made by the board, & excepts both manner & method used by the County Assessor in arriving at his conclusions in regard to the amount to be taxed against the Citizens' Light, Heat & Power Co. & gave notice of its intention to ask for a hearing in the matter before the State Tax Commission.
