So far as the Hoopes road was concerned the report of the views was that the matter be taken under advisement until legal advice can be obtained. The board concurred in this view and deferred action until a later date.

The report of the views on the road petitioned for by Mart Hartman and others recommended that the road be reduced from its present width of 66 feet to 45 feet for the first mile from point of beginning on the County line and that the remaining mile be reduced to a width of 40 feet. Upon motion made, seconded and passed, the board concurred in the recommendation of the views as above indicated.
