Section 5. - The chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, and the clerk of said board, are hereby authorized and directed to prepare and execute the bonds heretofore described and to procure their proper registration in the office of the County Clerk of said County, and in the office of the auditor of the State of Kansas, and to sell and deliver said bonds when so executed and registered to Fidelity National Bank & Trust Co., of Kansas City, Mo., in accordance with the contract between said Fidelity National Bank & Trust Co. and the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas.

Section 6. - The proceeds of the sale of said bones shall be deposited with the County Treasurer in the special fund herebefore provided for the purpose of paying for the cost of the improvement herebefore described.
