

The following stipulation, concerning the fill, was upon motion made, seconded & passed, unanimously adopted, & with stipulation.

Agree to
Stipulation

It is stipulated and agreed by and between the parties hereinafter named, to-wit: The Maple Grove Drainage District, the County of Douglas, Kansas, and the Bownock Mills & Power Company, that the fill in the Kansas river below the bridge at Lawrence, which was used as the south approach to the old bridge, shall be cut down and removed so that its height at its south end when it joins the dam shall not exceed three (3) feet above the top of the dam, and that it shall slope upward for approximately one hundred & twenty (120) feet, so that it shall not exceed seven (7) feet above the top of the dam at the north end thereof. The Bownock Mills & Power Company agrees to cut down and remove at its own cost and expense said fill as above indicated and to begin work thereon not later than September 1st, 1920, and to push forward the work with due diligence & speed.

All parties consent & agree that the Court make an order directed to the County of Douglas & The Bownock Mills & Power Company ordering the removal of said fill to the height indicated above.

Following the adoption of the stipulation aforesaid, upon agreement the following preamble & Resolution was upon motion made, seconded, & passed unanimously, to-wit:

Fill

Whereas, it was originally agreed between the County of Douglas and the Bownock Mills & Power Company to reduce the height of the fill ten (10) feet; and

Whereas, it is now agreed that said fill shall be removed and reduced in height so that it shall be three (3) feet above top of dam at south end and seven (7) feet above top of dam at north end;

Now, therefore, it is agreed that the expense incident to the removal and reduction below the height originally agreed upon by the County shall be borne by Douglas County.

The question of making a tax levy for the current year was then taken up and discussed at length, and the following levies for the 1920 county tax was determined upon & agreed to by the board. Basis of valuation, \$47,200,000 approximately:
