Unanimous A vote being ~~taken~~ ordered & taken on the adoption of the motion, Commissioners Cox, Hoover & Andrews vote yes, no not one vote being recorded negative, Chairman Andrews declared the motion adopted & the tax levies approved.

Mayor Upon motion of Commissioner Cox, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Hoover, & passed by a vote of three (3)

Against yes, & not one vote in the negative - Commissioner Andrews.

Certain Cox & Hoover voting yes - The board approved levies for interest and sinking funds for certain County school districts,
