

Saturday, September 18-1920

The Board met in regular session, all the Commissioners present, & Commissioner & Chairman A. Andrews presiding.

Upon motion made, seconded & passed: the board directed the clerk to communicate with the River Bonding & Surety Co. of Omaha, Neb., asking for a derivative joint amended stipulation providing for joining the work approach to the Kansas River bridge at Lawrence & a return to the original stipulation providing for back paving.

Saturday, September 25-1920.

Upon request of the County Health Officer, J. Venable, permission for admission to the Beech Grove Hospital at Rensselaer, Kans., for a period of two (2) weeks only -

The County treasurer was authorized to transfer \$563.74 from the County general funds for the state fund.

Saturday, October 7-1920.

The board met in regular session, Commissioners Cox and Hoover present, Commissioner Andrews absent. Commissioner Hoover presided.

The board directed the clerk to notify the Superintendent of the Beech Memorial Hospital that in the case of J. M. White & J. Venable, sent from this County to the hospital for care and treatment for a period of two (2) weeks, that the county would not be responsible for expense incident to this treatment for a period longer than two (2) weeks.
