

Monday, Nov. 1, 1920.

The board met this date for its first day's meeting of the November session. All the commissioners were present and Commissioner and Chairman A. Andrews presided.

Minutes Read & Approved

The minutes of the October meetings of the board were read, and upon motion duly made, seconded, and passed, approved.

To Make Daily Reports to County Engineer

Upon motion duly made, seconded and passed, the board ordered that every ^{county} employee in charge of the County Engineer make daily report to the County Engineer.

Compromise on Taxes

Upon motion duly made, seconded and passed, the board accepted as compromise for taxes for the years 1892, 1896, and 1900 on the following described real estate, situated in Palmyra Township, to-wit: The east half of the north $\frac{2}{3}$ of the east 23 acres of the west 63 acres of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 20, Twp. 14, R. 20. for the sum of \$200.00.

Order Cancellation of

Tax Against Mrs. F. Griffin

Upon motion duly made, seconded and passed, the board directed a cancellation of taxes appearing in the name of S. A. Griffin, executrix, to-wit: \$2,500. in the sum of \$65.17. Also personal property appearing in the name of S. A. Griffin, to-wit: the amount of \$700. on which there is tax of \$19.08, both items for the sum of \$87.25.

Claims Allowed

Claims against the county were presented, audited, and allowed, for which see November Allowance Record.

The board ordered a cancellation of amounts appearing on the 1920 tax roll in the name of Goldie Berry & Goldie Berry, guardian, on which taxes aggregating \$46.49 have been charged, it appearing to the satisfaction of the board that an erroneous assessment had been made in both instances.
