Continued

First: To select and hire a competent engineer and a competent attorney to look after and attend to the technical and legal problems involved.

Second: To cause a survey to be made embracing the territory to be effected by the proposed improvements and described generally as all that part of the City of Lawrence whose surface waters are drained by ditches running north from Oregon and Thirteenth Streets in the City of Lawrence, all of Woodland Park, and all that part of Wakarusa Township lying east of the City of Lawrence and whose surface waters are drained into and enter the ditches in and around Woodland Park.

Third: To proceed under the provisions of Article 4 of Chapter 31 of the General Statutes of Kansas of 1915 (Chapter 197 of the Laws of 1907, as amended by subsequent enactments) to make application of the District Court for drainage of such land as shall be shown by the survey to be made as being subject to benefit from the proposed work, and to suggest to the engineer that the drain to be constructed shall follow the following general direction: Commencing at or near the intersection of Thirteenth and Oregon streets in the City of Lawrence; thence north along the east side of the tracks of the Southern Kansas Railroad to the culvert now at the intersection of Twelfth street and Haskell Avenue; thence north to the Endora Road; thence east along said road to a point where the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company's tracks across said Endora Road; thence north to the Kansas River, and to cause inquiry to be made as to the expense and advisability of constructing either open or covered drains.

Fourth: To recommend to the Township Board of Wakarusa Township, the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, that all expenses which will not be taken care of by the assessments to be ordered by the District Court of Douglas County, Kansas, be paid in equal shares by the three bodies above named.

Fifth: To recommend that the three Boards above named have their representatives continue in charge of this preliminary work and when completed, to make application to the District Court as heretofore suggested.
