It was agreed by the board that Chairman A. Andrews act on

The annual report of the Township Board of Marion Twp. was
received, audited and approved.

Friday, Dec. 24, 1920

The board met in regular session. Commissioners Andrews
and Hauser present. Commissioner Cox absent owing to illness.
Commissioner and Chairman A. Andrews presided.

The board directed the Clerk to prepare and insert
advertisement in the official County paper, calling for
bids on the Belvoir Bridge to span the Wakarusa
creek in Clinton township, bids to be received until 12
o'clock noon of Jan. 20, 1921, and then opened.

A correction in the minutes of the Board meeting for Dec.
21-1920, was directed by the chairman to conform with the
action of the board, to wit: That bids calling for the
construction of a reinforced concrete bridge across the west
branch of Log creek, in Putnam township, on the road known as
the "Old Santa Fe Trail" road, be advertised in connection with
the bids for the construction of Belvoir bridge; that said bids be
received until 12 o'clock noon of Thursday, January 21-1921,
be then publicly opened.

Commissioner ~~Hauser~~ Hauser filed an objection to the action
as above indicated insofar as the bridge across the west branch
of Log creek is concerned.
