

Monday, Jan 10, 1921.

Commissioners Cox, Steele and Bretzinger, newly elected Douglas County Commissioners, met in the Commissioners' Board Room at the Court House at 10:30 o'clock this A.M. and reorganized as a Board of County Commissioners by the election of Commissioner A.L. Cox of the First Commissioner District, as Chairman of the Board.

Upon suggestion of the Chairman, and by motion, made seconded and passed, Commissioner Robert A. Steele, of the Third Commissioner District, was chosen as Temporary Chairman to act as such during the absence of Chairman Cox.

Geo. C. Brune, upon motion made, seconded and passed, was appointed County Clerk to act as such until the next General Election and until his successor is elected and qualified.

No applications were presented to the Board for the position of County Farm & Home Superintendent, to wit: G. C. Siger and Jesse Pieratt. A ballot was ordered to determine a selection between the two, which resulted: Siger 3, Pieratt 0. With the announcing of the result of the ballot, Chairman Cox declared G. C. Siger elected County Farm & Home Superintendent for a period of one year.

H. H. Gillum was elected custodian of the Court House for a period of one year, at a salary of \$70.00 a month, with the understanding that he was to devote all of his time to his duties as custodian.

Upon motion made, seconded and passed, the Journal-World was declared the official County paper for the ensuing year; the rate to be charged the usual legal rates.

The bond of Carl Phillips, chosen County Coroner, was filed and approved.

The road petition, of W. E. Beattie and fifteen others asking for the vacation of a road described as follows: Beginning at a point about 245 ft. West of N. E. Cor. of N. W. 1/4 of sec. 36-12-19. Wakarusa Twp. where the north line of road to Fort Highway crosses the north line of sec. 36-12-19, thence East to 1/4 sec. Cor., thence South along center line of sec. 36, 74 7/8 ft. to north line of road to Fort Highway, thence North 74° 50' West to a point 40 ft. West of center line of sec. 36, thence north to a point 40 ft. South of line of sec. 36, thence West on line 40 ft. South of, and parallel to North line of sec. 36, to point of intersection with North line of F. to F. Highway, thence north 74° 50' W. along north line of F. to F. Highway to point of beginning, and including all of County road lying north of N. line of F. to F. Highway in N. E. 1/4 of N. W. 1/4 of sec. 36-12-19, Wakarusa Twp., was
