The board took up the matter of repainting a number of the rooms (5 in all and hall) in the Sheriff's residence and the pipe rooms and hall used by the local G. A. R. Post, situate in the basement of the Court house. Three bids were received for this work: Walter & Albro, for \$225.00; D. A. Marshall, for \$40.00; and E. M. Culver & Son, for \$48.00.

Before the Contractor left Mr. Marshall appeared before the board and was granted permission to reduce his figures to \$120.00. Upon motion made, seconded and passed, the board accepted the bid of Mr. Marshall at the last named figure.
