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sional education in the Acacia Fraternity and to provide a suitable dwelling for The Kansas Chapter of The Acacia Fraternity, and to own real estate for that purpose, the said charter further providing that no dividends of profits shall be paid on the capital stock of the company;

Third: That said Association became the owner of the above mentioned real estate and the appurtenances on or about June 30th, 1919, thereafter took possession thereof and prepared the same as a suitable dwelling for the Kansas Chapter of the Acacia Fraternity, which commenced to occupy said real estate and appurtenances on or about August 1st, 1919, and has ever since said date so occupied and does now so occupy the same; That said property is not leased or otherwise used with a view of profit.

Fourth: That the Kansas Chapter of the Acacia Fraternity is an association of college students who belong to the Masonic Fraternity, and who are associated together to advance the cause of education among Masons. That said Chapter uses said real estate and the dwelling appurtenant thereto exclusively as a literary hall and dormitory, and that the dwelling on said real estate, together with one-half acre of the grounds appurtenant thereto are exempt from taxation under and by virtue of the provisions of Section 11,153 of the General Statutes of 1915 of the State of Kansas.

Fifth: That the above mentioned Association has elected to have the following described real estate, containing one-half acre of land and being the real estate of which the dwelling is situated, declared to be its exempt property, to wit:

Beginning at a point 22.4 rods north and 8.4 rods West of the South East Corner of section 36, township 12, Range 19; thence South 10 rods, thence West 8 rods; thence north 10 rods; thence East 8 rods to the point of beginning, all in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kans.

Sixth: That the portion of the real estate as described in Paragraph "First" hereof, less the portion thereof as described in paragraph "Fifth" hereof, is subject to taxation under the laws of the State of Kansas.

Seventh: That the taxes assessed for the year 1920 on the whole of said real estate should be

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
