cancelled for the reason that exempt real estate has been included, and that an assessment of the real estate subject to taxation should be made in the manner provided by law, and extended on the tax rolls, and said real estate is to be taxed being described as follows:

Beginning at the South East Corner of Section 36, Township 12, Range 19; thence west 20 rods; thence north 22.4 rods; thence east 20 rods; thence south 22.4 rods to the point of beginning, less beginning at a point 22.4 rods north and 8.4 rods west of the South East corner of section 36, Township 12, range 19; thence south 10 rods; thence west 8 rods; thence north 10 rods; thence east 8 rods to the point of beginning, all in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas.

Eighth: That, under the provisions of Chapter 321 of the Session Laws of 1917 of the State of Kansas, all proceedings herein had, should be submitted to the Tax Commission of the State of Kansas for its consideration, and for authority to strike said real estate as described in Paragraph "Fifth" hereof from the Tax rolls as exempt property.

It is therefore ordered (1) That the taxes for the year 1920 on the following described real estate, to wit:

Beginning at the South East Corner of Section 36, Township 12, range 19; thence west 20 rods; thence north 22.4 rods; thence east 20 rods; thence south 22.4 rods to the point of beginning, all in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas,

be cancelled;

(2) That the following described real estate be assessed for taxation for the year 1920, in the manner provided by law, to wit:

Beginning at the south east corner of section 36, Township 12, Range 19; thence west 20 rods; thence north 22.4 rods; thence east 20 rods; thence south 22.4 rods to the point of beginning, less beginning at a point 22.4 rods north and 8.4 rods west of the South east corner of section 36, township 12, range 19; thence south 10 rods; thence west 8 rods; thence north 10 rods; thence east 8 rods to the point of beginning, all in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, and upon said assessment being so made, that the taxes
