The board met in adjourned regular session, all the commissioners present, but Commissioner and Chairman A. L. Cox presiding.

Mitchell Board The board of N. A. Mitchell, elected Justice of the Peace for Colinton Township, was received and approved.

Upon motion duly made, seconded & passed, the board authorized the removal of what is known as the Rocky Ford bridge to the removal of the Jensen place, all expense connected with such removal to be borne by private individuals, the County to be at no expense. The request for the removal of the wreckage came through a spokesman for a delegation of citizens interested in having a crossing over Rock Creek near the Jensen place, the agreement being that they would remove the entire wreckage without expense to the County.

X Upon motion duly made, seconded & passed, the board made the following order:

Transfer Ordered, "That the sum of \$10,297.98 be, and the same is hereby transferred, from the County Bridge fund to the Fort to Fort Highway fund, to retire outstanding warrants issued in favor of C. C. Clark & Co., Contractors on Section B, Project No. 7, Federal Aid district No. 5, Fort to Fort Highway."
