

Saturday, February 26, 1921

The board met in regular session, all commissioners present, the Commissioner as Chairman A. L. Cox presiding.

The following resolution was presented & read, and upon motion duly made, seconded & passed, approved and ordered included in the proceedings of the board, as follows, to-wit:

"Be it resolved by the County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Kansas, that the County Clerk of said County, is hereby instructed and empowered to make answer to the furnished summons served upon said Douglas County in the case of S. Schrader & Ora Bulley vs. H. Schrader and Ora Bulley against Horace Young, and that said answer to said furnished summons contain the following facts, to-wit: That there is now nothing due the said Horace Young from said County since the 10th day of August, 1920, there having been an assignment on the 10th day of August, 1920, by said Horace Young of all funds due or to become due him from said Douglas County to the Watkins National Bank of the City of Lawrence, Kansas."

X This was the date set for receiving bids from local banks for the purchase of the \$100,000 Road Improvement bonds. One bid of \$93.37 per hundred, was received. While the board was discussing this bid an offer was received over the telephone from the Brown-Crummer Company of \$94.50 per hundred. The board, without taking action on either of the two bids, directed the clerk to notify not only Brown-Crummer Company, but also other Kansas City bond houses to submit bids for this \$100,000 issue of Douglas County Road Improvement bonds, bids to be received and opened Wednesday, March 2. The board reserving the right to waive technicalities and to reject any and all bids -
