

Monday, March 7, 1921.

The board met this date for the first day of the March session. All the Commissioners were present, and Commissioner Cox presided.

The minutes of the February meeting of the board were read by the clerk, and upon motion duly made, seconded and approved.

The board of the Merchants National Bank, in amount \$30,000, and the depository bond of the Merchants Loan & Savings bank, in amount \$10,000, were received and approved.

The appointment of Mr. Frank Evans as deputy assessor for the city of Lawrence, to fill the place of Mr. C. R. Peters, who is unable to serve, was brought before the board by the County Assessor and approved upon motion duly made, seconded and passed.

Claims against the county were presented, audited and allowed, for which see March Allowance Record.

Tuesday, March 8, 1921.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all Commissioners present, and Commissioner Cox presiding.

The board approved the bond of Walter O. McClanahan, appointed trustee of Leamington township.

By direction of an order issued by the State Tax Commission, the board ordered a refund, in amount \$5.45, in favor of Mrs. D. L. Bank, acct. failure of Deputy Assessor to allow the constitutional exemption of \$200.

Upon motion duly made, seconded and passed, the board adopted the following resolution, to wit:

Be it resolved, by the board of County Commissioners of Douglas County that, in accordance with the provisions of Kohler (S.3.37) we do hereby request the State Highway Commission of Kansas to furnish us for use in constructing or maintaining public highways, the following equipment:

1. tractor with caterpillar tracks.
