

The title of said equipment to remain with the state.
 We agree to pay to the United States Department of Agriculture for the state the amount of 20 per centum of the estimated value of said property, such value to be fixed by the Department of Agriculture. It is understood that against this 20 per centum the state will set off all freight charges paid by the County not to exceed 20 per centum.

It is further understood and agreed that the Board of County Commissioners will pay the State Highway Commission a fair rental charge as required by the Federal act, which charge will be not less than the cost of maintenance and repair of such equipment.

The Board further certifies that the equipment requested will be used for the improvement or maintenance of highways within a reasonable time after it is received.
