The bill of The Lawrence Memorial Hospital for \$103.92 for services was upon motion duly made, seconded and passed, rejected.

Saturday, April 9 - 1921

The board listened to a delegation of citizens from Baldwin and Palmyra Townships, on the question of the construction of the old Santa Fe Trails Road.

Claims against the County were presented, audited and allowed, for which see April Allowance Record.

The board directed the Clerk to issue an order to the County Treasurer, authorizing the cancellation of town of tax to the following described real estate to wit:

Begin N. E. cor. lot 25 Delaware St. city of Lawrence. Thence S. 20 ft., N. 42 1/4 ft., N. 122 ft., E. 87 ft., for the years 1911, 1912, 1913, 1914, 1915, 1916, 1917, and to strike parcel off tax roll.
