Open bids

At 11 o'clock A. M. The board opened bids for the construction of hard surface on Sec. 12, E. and F. Project no 7 of hard surface Federal Aid Road District No 5. St. to St. Highway.

Sec. 12, E. & F.

Three bids were received, namely: Fred J. Eberhardt, Salina, Kansas; Jiegler and Dalton Const. Co. of Junction City, Kansas; and W. Patterson & Co. Kansas City, Mo. The bid of Eberhardt was on Sec. E. only, and was for \$139,240.30.

The bid of Jiegler & Dalton Const. Co. was for all three of the sections and totaled \$411,267.10.

The bid of Patterson & Co. was for all three sections and aggregated \$412,615.45.

The Engineer's estimate for the three sections was \$30,840.74.

After reading the bids the board announced an adjournment until 2:30 P. M. to give time for the Engineer to look over the figures in the different bids and ascertain which was lowest.

At 2:30 P. M. the board reconvened and after listening to the report of the Engineer awarded the contract on all three sections, namely 12, E. & F. to the Jiegler & Dalton Const. Co., of Junction City, Kansas, upon motion of Commissioner Kratzenberg.
