

Monday, June 6 - 1921.

The board met this date, for the first day of the June session, all Commissioners present and Commissioner & Chairman A. L. Cox presiding.

The minutes of the board meetings for the month of May were read by the clerk and upon motion duly made, seconded & passed, approved.

The bond of the Jiegler & Dalton Construction Co., of Junction City, Kansas, successful bidders on the construction work of the land surface on sections D, E, and F, Project No. 7, Federal Aid Road District No. 5, Ft. to Ft. Highway, with the Aetna Casualty & Surety Co. of Hartford, Conn., as sureties, was received by the board, closely scrutinized, and receiving the recommendation of the County Attorney, was upon motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved by them.

Following the application of Mr. W. H. Banning and his verbal explanation, the board, by motion duly made, seconded and passed, authorized the clerk to notify the County Treasurer, of the cancellation of tax for the year 1859 in lot 11 block 40, City of LeCompton, Douglas County, in amount 38 cents.

Claims against the county were presented, audited, and allowed, for which see June Allowance Record.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all the Commissioners present, and Commissioner & Chairman A. L. Cox presided.

The bond of O. J. Lane County Superintendent, was received and approved.

Carrying out the order of the State Tax Commission the board, upon motion duly made seconded, and passed, ordered a refunding order issued to Mr. J. R. Edmonds, in amount of \$23.85, in repayment for \$25.00 valuation for a note which Mr. Edmonds owed, and which the deputy assessor had listed as owned by him.
