Whereas, The Board of Commissioners of the City of Law-
rence, Douglas County, Kansas, has adopted a resolution pro-
viding for the improvement of North Seventh Street in that part
of said City commonly known as North Lawrence, from the in-
tersection of said North Seventh Street and Locust Street
north to the north city limits, by paving said North Seventh
Street at a width of eighteen feet, with such width at corners
as good engineering practice may require, the said paving
